INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

2009 SENIOR CLASS MARSHALS

- Two Syracuse University rising seniors will be selected as the all-university representatives for commencement activities in 2009.
- The Marshals will lead their entire class into Syracuse University's 155th Commencement ceremonies on May 10, 2009 in the Carrier Dome.
- Only Syracuse University juniors graduating in May 2009 who are enrolled in undergraduate programs and will be studying on-campus for the entire 2008-2009 academic year are eligible to apply (i.e. not studying abroad).
- Selection criteria will be based upon scholarship, academic honors, student organization involvement, campus service, community service, school spirit, and written essay.
- All Senior Class Marshal applicants are required to submit a typed essay. Please answer the following question in no more than 250 words. **Syracuse University is a diverse institution of higher education where academic excellence is profoundly connected to ideas, problems, and professions in the world. Syracuse University encourages students, faculty, and staff to be enterprising, willing to engage Scholarship in Action, and attuned to our communities, at home and abroad. Consequently, what does Scholarship in Action mean to you, and how have you demonstrated that meaning during your time spent as an undergraduate student at Syracuse University?**
- Interviews for those applicants selected as finalists will take place during the week of March 31 –April, 2008 (dates subject to change).

- Applicants must obtain two signatures of nomination. Please note that nominators must be members of Syracuse University's faculty and/or staff.
- All applicants must print legible responses on the official nomination form.
- Obtain nominator signatures only after completing the official nomination form.
- Please do not submit a resume or add pages. Only the official nomination form should be used in responding to questions. Additional pages will NOT be reviewed.
- Remember to include an official Syracuse University transcript and essay with your official application form.
- **DEADLINE for application is Friday, March 28, 2008 at 5:00 p.m.**
