

TEMPORARY HOUSING

Dear Incoming Fall 2008 Student:

HOUSING UPON YOUR ARRIVAL: If you need housing upon arrival in Syracuse, reservations are required. If you have not made previous housing arrangements and you arrive in Syracuse after 4:00 p.m., you should plan on staying in a hotel. Options are listed below and *reservations are required*.

Hotels

The **Sheraton Syracuse University Hotel** (<http://www.sheratonsyracuse.com/>) offers a discounted rate of \$94.00 single occupancy or \$111.00 double occupancy for International Students. It is strongly recommended that you make a reservation. To do so you must call the hotel directly at 800-395-2105 or 315-475-3000 from 8am-6pm Monday through Friday. Explain that you are an International Student and would like the discounted rate. *The discounted rate is based on availability.* If you would like to share a room with another International Student please let the hotel know when you are making your reservation. The hotel will try to pair you with a second student. If you arrive at the hotel without making a reservation, the discounted rate may not be available, so it is highly recommended to call the hotel before you arrive. Upon your arrival please present your passport and Form I-20 or DS-2019 to indicate you qualify for the reduced rate. (These rates are valid from June 2008 – June 2009).

OTHER HOTELS

Comments: Be sure to identify yourself as an incoming international student when you make your reservation and when you check into the hotel. Also, please present your passport, and I-20 or DS-2019. Costs will vary. Please check for prices at each hotel.

Price: Both properties have the same policies: Student discount is \$ 79 for a single room per day – no tax – housekeeping every 3 days, all utilities included. The Parkview Hotel suites include a kitchen (for \$79 per night).

Availability (as of 07/25/08): Still have lot of availability, though the 19th of August will be sold out soon.

Transportation: driver to and from airport, to campus, around Syracuse, etc. is included in price. Students can call from complimentary call center at the airport to get picked up. The driver will be sent to them.

Price: Student discount is at \$119 for single room with king size bed; If two people stay in the room, it is \$129.

Availability (as of 07/25/08): Still some availability, but days with the student discount are filling up fast. For instance, the student discount is already not available on August 8 or on August 11.

Transportation: A hotel shuttle is available to the airport, and also within a 5 mile radius of the hotel (this includes the Syracuse University campus).

Price: Student discount is \$94 (single)/ \$111(double) (only available on August 17th). Without the discount, rooms starting from \$199.

Availability (as of 07/25/08): Student discount is booked, except for 1 day (August 17th)

Transportation: Shuttle included in price, students can call from complementary station at the airport.

If you have a South Campus housing assignment or plan to live on South Campus for Fall 2008, you may contact the South Campus Housing office directly to determine the date your housing will be available. **With prior approval**, it may be possible for you to move into your permanent housing on August 20, 2008.

North Campus Housing at the University

If you have a North Campus University housing assignment for Fall 2008, and you plan on arriving in Syracuse between August 11 and August 19 you should plan to stay in a hotel. If you plan on arriving in Syracuse on or after August 20, 2008, you will be allowed to check-in directly to your assigned residence hall without extra charge.

Another important item to keep in mind: the meal plan in the residential dining halls will not begin until Monday, August 25, 2008. Therefore, you will be responsible for all of your meals until that time. There are dining centers on campus, and local restaurants nearby (within easy walking distance). You should anticipate spending about \$40 per day for meals until the meal plan begins on Monday (depending on your own meal choices).
